There was a Community Safety Meeting at the Lodge Wednesday evening (Nov 8th) with the Denver Police Dept. A summary of the meeting has been posted to TownSq. Our CRO sent information about a new technology that the police dept. will be using to reduce workload and free up time for dispatchers so that they can more readily respond to calls.
